HOW TO REPLACE CITIZENSHIP OR NATURALIZATION CERTIFICATE

A Naturalization Certificate is the official document issued by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) as proof that a person has been granted citizenship through naturalization.

A Certificate of Citizenship is the official document issued by the USCIS as proof that a person obtained U.S. citizenship through the United States citizenship of at least one birth parent, regardless if the birth took place overseas, or if the parents became naturalized when the person was under age 18.

USCIS Form N-565 is used to apply for the replacement of either the Naturalization or Citizenship Certificate. The cost of replacing the Certificate is \$345 (June 2013).
