

## Pennsylvania's Voter ID Rules

### Voting in Person

**Pennsylvania asks for ID the first time you vote in your precinct.**

**You can use one of these photo IDs:**

- PA driver's license
- PA state ID card
- Photo ID issued by PA or US government
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Employee ID

**Or you can use a non-photo ID that has your name and address:**

- Voter registration card
- Firearm permit
- Non-photo ID issued by PA or US government
- Current utility bill, bank statement, or paycheck

### Voting by Mail

Any registered Pennsylvania voter can vote by mail.

**When you request your mail-in ballot, you need to provide:**

- Number from your PA driver's license or state ID card (if you have one)
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security number (if you don't have PA license or state ID card)

**If you don't have any of these numbers:**

- Check the box on your application form
- Include copy of an accepted form of ID

## 2024 Primary Elections

**Voter Registration Deadline:** April 8

**Deadline to Request Mail-in Ballot:** April 16

**Election Day:** April 23
