Yoting in Person

You can cast a regular ballot if you present one of these photo IDs:

Texas driver's license

Texas personal ID card

Texas election certificate

U.S. Passport book or card

Handgun license

Military ID

U.S citizenship certificate (Does not expire)

Your ID must be unexpired <u>or</u> expired up to 4 years. It can be expired longer if you are 70 years or older.

If you do not have one of the IDs listed above:

You can cast a regular ballot if you present a supporting form of ID <u>and</u> complete/sign a "Reasonable Impediment Declaration."

Supporting IDs

Voter registration certificate

Certified U.S. birth certificate (including territory)

Current utility bill, bank statement, or paycheck*

Government check*

Other government document*
(Examples: employee ID, out-of-state ID)

*Must show your name <u>and</u> any address.



Voting by Mail

Only certain voters are eligible to vote by absentee ballot in Texas.

You must include specific identifying information twice – when you apply for your ballot and when you return it.
