

In Alaska you are asked to show an ID to vote in person

Alaska requests ID to vote in person.

 ID with name + signature. Or ID with name + address.

Common examples include:

- AK voter ID card
- Driver's license or state ID card issued by any state
- Hunting or fishing license issued by any state

Photo ID:

Must be unexpired

- Military ID
- US passport or passport card
- Student ID
- Other photo ID

ID that has your name and address:

Must be current

- Utility bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- Government check
- Other government document

If you don't have an ID,
you can sign a form (called
questioned ballot).
