In Colorado you do not need ID to vote by mail


except for some first time voters

To vote in person, you are asked to show an ID or sign a form

To vote in person, Colorado requests ID.

 If your ID shows an address, it must be in Colorado.

You can show:

Must be unexpired.

- Colorado driver's license
- CO State ID card
- US passport
- Tribal ID
- Student photo ID issued by CO high education institution
- Military ID
- Current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document (*must have name and address*)

If you don't have an ID, sign a form (called an affidavit) and vote a provisional ballot.
