To vote in person, you must confirm your identity

Confirm your identity at the polls by:

- Reciting your name, address, and date of birth
- Having another registered voter confirm who you are
- Showing an accepted form of ID

Accepted ID include:

Must be unexpired

- HI driver's license
- HI state ID card
- US passport
- Military ID issued by US government

Must have name and address

- Utility bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- Government check
- Government document
