Kansas requires photo ID to vote in person.

ID must have your name and photo

Most people show:

Unexpired or no expiration date. ID can be expired if you are 65 or older.

- Driver's license or state ID card issued by any state

You can also show:

Unexpired or no expiration date. ID can be expired if you are 65 or older.

- US passport
- Student ID issued by accredited higher ed institution in KS
- Tribal ID
- Military ID
- Public assistance ID
- Employee ID issued by US, KS, or local government
- Concealed handgun license issued by any state
