

Oklahoma requests ID to vote in person.

ID must show your name

You can show ID issued by:

Unexpired or show no expiration date

- OK or US government
- Federally-recognized tribe
- US Military

You can also show:

- Voter ID card issued by county board of elections

If you don't have an ID, sign a form (called an affidavit) and vote by provisional ballot.
