In Pennsylvania voters are asked to show ID the first time they vote in their precinct

Pennsylvania requests ID the first time you vote in your precinct.

Non-photo ID must have your name and address

Most people show:

- PA driver's license
- PA state ID card
- Photo ID issued by PA or US government
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Employee ID

You can also show:

- Voter registration card
- Firearm permit
- Non-photo ID issued by PA or US government
- Current utility bill, bank statement, or paycheck
