## Utah requires a UT driver's license or UT state ID the first time you vote by mail or in person.

After you vote by mail for the first time in Utah, ID is not required.

If you vote in person, you must confirm your identity:

## Show 1 photo ID:

Must be unexpired

- UT driver's license
- · UT state ID card
- ID issued by US government
- Tribal ID (does not need photo)
  Bank statement
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID issued by UT or US government
- US concealed weapon permit

Or, show 2 IDs that prove your name and current address when combined:

- Utility bill (Dated within 90 days) of election)
- Social security card
- Paycheck
- ID issued by UT institution of higher education (must be unexpired)
