# Utah requires a UT driver's license or UT state ID the first time you vote by mail or in person.

**After you vote by mail for the first time in Utah, ID is not required.**

**If you vote in person, you must confirm your identity:**

**Show 1 photo ID:**

*Must be unexpired*

- UT driver's license
- UT state ID card
- ID issued by US government
- Tribal ID (*does not need photo*)
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID issued by UT or US government
- US concealed weapon permit

**Or, show 2 IDs that prove your name and current address**

**when combined:**

- Utility bill (*Dated within 90 days of election*)
- Bank statement
- Social security card
- Paycheck
- ID issued by UT institution of higher education (*must be unexpired*)
