Wisconsin requires photo ID to vote in person.

ID must have your name and photo

Most people show:

Ok if expired after Nov. 5, 2024

- WI driver's license
- · WI state ID card
- Military ID issued by US
- US passport

You can also show:

- Veterans Affairs Card (Unexpired or no expiration)
- Tribal ID issued by tribe in WI (Ok if expired)
- Certificate of Naturalization
 (Issued within 2 years)
- Photo receipt from WI DMV

If you're a student, you can show student ID issued by institution accredited in WI:

- Must show your signature
- Must show date of issuance and expiration date
- Must expire within 2 years of issuance date
- If your ID is expired, you must also show proof of enrollment (examples: tuition fee receipt, course schedule)
