Are you a first time voter?

If you didn't verify your identity and residency when you registered, you may need to show ID to vote in your first election. You can show:

- DC license (*unexpired*) **or**
- ID card issued by the DC DMV (*unexpired*) **or**
- A utility bill, bank statement, or paycheck (*issued within 90 days*)
