

Wisconsin's Voter ID Rules

Wisconsin requires photo ID to vote.

In Person: You must show an accepted ID.

By Mail: You need to include a copy of accepted ID with your **first** absentee ballot request.

Accepted Photo IDs

Most people use:

Ok if expired after Nov. 8, 2022

- WI driver's license
- WI state ID card
- US passport
- Military ID

If you're a student, you can use student ID issued by an institution accredited in WI:

- Must show your signature
- Must show issuance date
- Must show an expiration date that is within 2 years of issuance
- If your ID is expired, you must also show current proof of enrollment (examples: tuition fee receipt, course schedule)

You can also use:

- Veterans Affairs Card
(Unexpired or no expiration)
- Tribal ID issued by tribe in WI
(Can be expired)
- Certificate of Naturalization
(Issued within 2 years)
- WI DMV Petition Process receipt

Online and Mail Registration Deadline: July 24

Deadline to Request Absentee Ballot: Aug 11

Election Day: Aug 13 *(Same-day registration available!)*
