## Voter ID Rules

### Voting in Person

Pennsylvania only asks for ID the **first time** you vote in your precinct.

**You can show one of these photo IDs:**

*Must be unexpired.*

- PA driver's license
- PA state ID card
- Photo ID issued by PA or US government
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Employee ID

**Or you can show a non-photo ID that has your name and address:**

- Voter registration card
- Non-photo ID issued by PA or US government
- Current utility bill, bank statement, government check, or paycheck
- Firearm permit

### Voting by Mail

Any registered PA voter can request a mail ballot.

**Give one of these numbers when requesting your mail-in or absentee ballot:**

- Number from your PA driver's license or PA state ID card (must use if you have one)
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security number

**If you don't have any of these numbers:**

- Check the box on your application form
- Include copy of an accepted ID

## 2026 Primary Election

**Voter Registration Deadline:** May 4

**Deadline to Request Mail Ballot:** May 12

**Election Day:** May 19
