Voter ID Rules

Voting in Person

Georgia requires photo ID to vote.

You can show one of these photo IDs:

- GA driver's license (*Ok if expired*)

Must be unexpired

- GA state ID card
- ID issued by US government or any state
- GA Voter ID card
- US passport or passport card
- Student ID from GA public college or university approved by GA Secretary of State
- Tribal ID
- Military ID
- Employee ID issued by US, GA, or local government

Voting by Mail

Any registered GA voter can request a mail ballot.

Give one of these numbers when requesting your absentee ballot (must use if you have one):

- Number from your GA driver's license
- Number from your GA state ID card

If you don't have one of these numbers, provide:

- Copy of accepted photo ID
- Copy of utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or government document with your name and address

You must also include an ID number or copy of ID when you return your absentee ballot!

Voter Registration Deadline: April 20

Deadline to Request Mail Ballot: May 8

Statewide Early Voting: April 27 - May 15

Election Day: May 19
