Voter ID Rules

Arizona requires ID to vote in person.
ID is not required to vote by mail.

Voting in Person

You have three options:

Option 1: Show one photo ID with name and address that matches your voter registration.

Must be unexpired or show no expiration date.

- AZ driver's license
- AZ state ID card
- Tribal ID
- Military ID
- Photo ID issued by US, AZ, or local government

Option 2: Show two non-photo IDs with name and address that match your voter registration.

Must be current or show no expiration date.

- Utility bill (including phone, internet, cable)
- Bank or credit union statement
- Tribal ID
- Property tax statement
- Recorder's certificate
- AZ vehicle registration or insurance card
- ID issued by US, AZ, or local government
- Any mail labeled "official election material"

Option 3: Show a combination of IDs from options 1 and 2.

One photo ID (from option 1) with missing or incorrect address + One non-photo ID with address that matches your voter registration

Examples:

- US passport + Utility bill
- Military ID + Vote registration card

2026 Primary Election

Voter Registration Deadline: June 22

Deadline to Request Mail Ballot: July 7

Statewide Early Voting: June 24

Election Day: July 21
