Voter ID Rules Voting in Person

Florida asks for photo ID to vote in person.

You have two options:

Option 1: Show one photo ID with your signature

Cannot be expired.

- FL driver's license
- FL state ID card
- US passport
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Public assistance ID
- Veterans health ID card (VHIC) issued by VA
- Retirement center ID
- Neighborhood association ID
- Debit or credit card
- FL concealed weapons license
- Employee ID issued by FL, US, or local government

Option 2: Show one photo ID (from list above) without signature + one other ID that has signature

Examples:

- Student ID + Debit card
- Passport card + Credit card

Voting by Mail

Any registered Florida voter can request to vote by mail. You must renew your request every two years.

You must provide one of the following numbers with your vote-by-mail ballot request:

- FL driver's license or state ID card number
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security number

You do not need to include ID when you return your completed ballot.

2026 Primary Election

Voter Registration Deadline: July 20
(Same-day registration available during early voting!)

Statewide Early Voting: August 8-15

Deadline to Request Mail Ballot: August 6

Election Day: August 18
