Voter ID Rules

Voting in Person

You can vote a regular ballot if you show one of these photo IDs:

Cannot be expired.

- TX driver's license
- TX state ID card
- TX Election ID Certificate (EIC)
- US passport or passport card
- US Citizenship Certificate
- Military ID
- TX handgun license

If you don't have an accepted photo ID, show:

- Voter registration certificate
- Certified US birth certificate
- Current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document with your name and an address

And complete and sign a Reasonable Impediment Declaration to vote a regular ballot.

Voting by Mail

Absentee ballots in Texas are only for some voters.

You must provide an ID number with your absentee ballot application AND your completed ballot.

You can use:

- TX driver's license number
- TX state ID card number
- TX Election ID Certificate number
- Last 4 digits of Social Security number
